

Cleaning & Maintenance Guideline Stardust Collection Interlocking

A) Post Installation Cleaning:

- When installation is complete, sweep floor to remove any debris then vacuum thoroughly to remove all surface dust and dirt.
- Damp mop using a neutral PH cleaner diluted with warm water using a microfiber mop. (See dilution rates on label).
 - o Use a two-bucket system and change the water frequently.
 - o Do not use any oil base cleaners as they will deteriorate the mats.
- If floor has been unprotected during construction and an excessive amount of dirt or dust is present additional cleaning with an auto scrubber may be required.
 - o An RPM of 185 and brush pressure between 35lbs and 80lbs is recommended.
 - o If disc type equipment is used, be sure to use a soft nylon brush, not a pad.
- Do not flood floor.
- Allow to dry thoroughly.
- Apply a treatment of DinoCoat according to instruction provided by Known Collection.


B) General Maintenance:

Sealed/Non-Sealed Floors

- Typically, Known Collection products require less than other types of flooring.
 - Sweeping then damp mopping with a microfiber mop is the preferred method.
 - o Do not use a string mop.
 - Use a two-bucket system with a neutral PH cleaner and change water frequently.
 - Products containing solvents and acids will attack the composite structure of the rubber flooring and cause deterioration.
 - o Sealants, waxes, etc. can alter the surface characteristics and appearance.
 - Known Collection does not assume any responsibility for damages caused by chemical additives.
 - o A protective coating such as DinoCoat is required for Stardust products, be sure to apply a coating after cleaning.

C) Floor Treatment

- Please note that treating Stardust Collection products is required.
 - Stardust products must be coated with DinoCoat. Any Stardust installations that are not coated will not be covered under warranty.
- Mats with a predominance of light-colored EPDM will be easier to clean and maintain if treatment is applied.
- DinoCoat will protect the cork granules in the product and is recommended to improve the visual effects of shade variation and uneven distribution of color granules.
- Please follow the below application guide to reapply the coating:
 - o Preparation:
 - Ensure floor has been completely cleaned and free of any dust, dirt or debris.
 - Ensure floor is completely dry before applying DinoCoat.
 - Isolate or close off area(s) that will have DinoCoat applied.
 - Line mop bucket with garbage bag to eliminate DinoCoat from entering the bucket and eliminate the possibility of foreign substance or unwanted chemicals
 - o Applying DinoCoat:
 - Pour DinoCoat into a bucket, using a roller or microfiber mop and slightly wringing it out so the mop is fully saturated but not dripping.
 - Apply a thin coat starting at the entrance way and outline the room along the baseboards, do a 180° turn back to the 3rd wall and cover the rest of the area working back and forth. (See below image)
 - Set up all caution/wet floor signs to ensure there is no traffic on floor while DinoCoat is drying.
 - DinoCoat must be completely dry before applying subsequent coats (minimum 1 hour). Drying times will vary with temperature, humidity and ventilation.
 - When applying a second coat, be sure to move in opposite direction from first coat.
